It was established by a group of like-minded social workers who have been working in the fields of basic education, health, Art & culture, environmental protection, rural development, women empowerment, and human rights. The organization began with very limited resources as well as manpower the organization aims to the empowerment of the economically weaker & socially marginalized section of the society through capacity building of the people.

The organization began with very limited resources as well as manpower. The organization aims to the holistic development of the society through capacity building of the people to strengthen with the provision of basic human needs, minimum amenities of life on an equitable basis.

A healthy mind in a healthy body is more desirable than anything else in life. “**Sabera Foundation and Research Institute**” has taken much care to improve health and sanitation through adequate awareness. This organization **Sabera Foundation and Research Institute** has been formed by a group of likeminded committed health & education, Social and field level activist. The member of the trust largely consists of volunteers who are professional in social, legal awareness programmed and activists. The trust has been active all over Delhi and Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal. The following are the main approaches based on which the strategies and programmed of the society are designed. Sabera Foundation and Research Institute helping the poor for education, and help from society activity and through of fund all poor people and student in all over in Delhi. Following are the activities were conducted during the financial year 2019-2020:

1. SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN PROGRAMME

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute organized several programs at Raafiah College of Education, Budaun of U.P. State. Our motive is to clean and green city. As a part of the 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan', a rally was taken out by Mohd. Habibur Rahaman chief functionary of Sabera Foundation & Research Institute, students to sensitize people in the Sahaswan area of Budaun. The respected principal of Raafiah College of Education led the rally with students, teachers, and a group of local people carrying placards displaying messages to sensitize people about cleanliness. Students, as well as teachers, participated with enthusiasm in the cleanliness drive.

2. SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME

Society has always kept in mind that vocational training is the need of the hour to reduce the effects of unemployment. Society has organized a vocational training center at our head office in Budaun, UP. During the Financial year, 2019-20 under review 50 students have imparted training in typing and shorthand. Many of these trainees are now self-employed. The Society has been conducting computer Training course with own fund of the society and providing training on computers educations and information technology. The computer is the necessity of the present time. This is the age of computer and Information Technology. If a youth is computer literate, she/he can get a job very easily. Keeping the importance of computer education in mind, Sabera Foundation & Research Institute has initiated a computer education program for young boys and girls. There is one center is running in which 5 trainees are getting training.

3. FREE HEALTH CHECKUP PROGRAMME

A Free Health Checkup Camp organized in July 2019 in Barakhamba, New Delhi to the needy men or women in the area and provide other free of cost health care services. Also, We had started taking nominal costs against some of the Health programs given to them. It was organized for 2 days long and we're getting eye check-ups free of charge. Within these 2 days, our organization has covered almost 200 people within this surrounding area. Our organization has decided to cover more people in its next session. Our focus people are old and needy people. This is just to create seriousness towards the services they get from the organization.

4. BOOK FAIR PROGRAMME

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute organized a Book fair program in Budaun in November 2019. It was a very motivating fair in this fair more than 35 publishers come and takes part in that book fair. More than 1500 people come to take it as a valuable fair. They enjoy every part of that fair and they learn more about books especially youth.

5. ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The society organized a camp at Budaun, UP, on world environment day to discuss the impact of growing pollution on human health and the environment. The eminent speakers discussed the factors leading to an increase in all types of pollution including water air and sound Pollution. It was felt that there is a need to speed the process of removing old vehicles Reduce the use of plastics, compulsory use the effluent treatment plants by controlling the pollution. On the same day, the society organized a program comprising a painting contest and participants of different schools. At the end of the program, prizes were distributed among the winners of the contest.

6. RETAILER TRAINING PROGRAMME

Retailer Training Programme was organized in May 2019. The Trust has been conducting Retailer Training course with own fund of the trust and providing training on every retail sector. Keeping the importance of retail education in mind, Sabera Foundation and Research Institute have initiated Retailer Training Programme for young boys and girls. There is one center is being run in which 20 trainees are getting training.

7. URDU AWARENESS PROGRAMME

An Urdu Awareness Programme was organized in January 2021. For the promotion of the Urdu language and to introduce the literary work written in the Urdu language our organization has organized an event in the name of great Poet and thinker Ghalib to celebrate his literary work in Urdu language and to promote Urdu through Urdu Shayari and proses. SFRI has always been dedicated to the promotion of the Indian Language and to taking these languages in between common people by organizing cultural events of languages and other events in this concern. Overall 200 people have participated in this event. The contemporary renowned Urdu poets were also being present on this occasion. A mushaira program was held for the embracement and endorsement of the magic of the Urdu language.

8. YOGA DAY CELEBRATION PROGRAMME

On the 7th of April 2019, the society in collaboration with PHSC and Raafiah College of education conducted an hour yoga session for the interested children and locals in the Sahaswan area. The health worker gave a talk on the importance of a healthy lifestyle through keeping oneself fit and fine physically, mentally, and emotionally. The group learned to perform Surya Namaskar and spent the rest of the time, learning to breathe, reflect and relax their mind and body.

9. DAY CELEBRATION PROGRAMME

• Women's Day Celebration

On 8th March 2019, the volunteers and trustees of the organization needed to appreciate and acknowledge the contribution of women to the entire world. Sabera Foundation and Research Institute celebrated Women's day, the program was held at Regd. office Barakhamba, New Delhi. Also hosted an event titled Stree Shakti in an endeavor to create awareness about women's emancipation.

• World Environment Day

SFRI has organized "World Environment Day "on 5th June 2019 at Budaun, Uttar Pradesh with daylong activities including tree plantation, sapling distribution, and competition were held to mark this occasion. More than 200 people attended this program.

10. ART & CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute work to promote the high value of humanity, brotherhood, peace, and harmony among people through cultural development activities. It works to create an environment of communal harmony and national integration in its working areas. In this context several activities like, Independence Day Celebration, Republic Day Celebration, Cultural Shows in Evening, Performance of Folk Music and Dance, Stage and Street Plays, and SFRI Annual Day Celebration are being organized in the working areas.

11. BETI BACHAO BETI PADAO PROGRAMME

The 'BETI BACHAO, BETI PADHAO' program is the best solution to address the status of women as a high number of secondary school dropouts. Currently, girls are less likely to complete their education and have only half the probability of getting enrolled in school compared to boys. Without education, girlchildren choose to deliver early and experience delivery-related complications and witness children born with a low survival rate.

12. CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAMME

After enforcement of the consumer protection act 1986, the initiative gathered momentum. But it is observed that the consumers of the rural and urban areas are yet to come within the fold. The consumer domains have expanded to the areas like Good Governance, information regarding spurious goods, healthy environment, enforcing standard necessities food safety and quality control right to information, etc. but due to lack of awareness and guidance at the grass-root level. The consumers are not able to avail themselves and exercise their rights. We had organized this program to help the people and spread awareness on this topic. People should their rights and benefits from the government also we had organized a legal awareness program.

13. MARTIAL ART PROGRAMME

SFRI organized on 24th August 2019, foundation day Programme in Raafiah college of Education, Badaun, UP. Trust collaboration with RCE staff and students conducted an hour of martial art activities session for students and interested children and locals in the nearby areas. The instructor teaches different moves of Karate and Kung Fu, also brief how important martial art is for self, mind, and body, healthy lifestyle through keeping oneself fit and fine physically, mentally and emotionally.

14. VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

Under the income generation of the organization, SFRI is providing vocational training on sewing, cutting, and weaving to 100 marginal women in the Malda district of West Bengal State. The training is conducted by expert instructors simultaneously batch-wise. Follow up process will start after the completion of the project.

Under the income generation of the organization, SFRI is providing Design & Technical Development Training on Terracotta & Pottery and Cane products in Malda to 100 marginal youths and poor women. Inputs on how to make attractive Terracotta & Pottery and cane products are demonstrated by expert instructors. The artisans are also oriented on commercial demand for innovative products in the market. The training is done simultaneously batch-wise. Networking with the financial institutions will begin after the completion of the project.

15. EARTH DAY CELEBRATION PROGRAMME

SFRI organized an Earth day celebration program in Feb 2020, a day-long program has organized in Raafiah College of Education, Budaun, U.P. To its effort to work for the environment awareness SFRI decided to celebrate Earth day program by its member's contribution and community

participation. Where students, environment activists, local administration, academicians, and other local people had invited. The program has included the Drawing and painting competition for kids on the theme of our planet Earth. The prizes were distributed to the winning kids and a certificate had provided to every participant. The Honorable resource person delivered their valuable speech to all present participants. Overall 300 people get benefitted and were acknowledged by the discourse and symposium on environmental concern by the resource person. On this occasion, a record number of 250 plants got planted by the participants and our guests. An Oath has taken by all the participants for conservation of our beloved planet and to plant tree ours near around.

16. TELECOM TRAINING PROGRAMME

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute are always dedicated to making youngster's self-dependent and those who are not in a position to stand for them. SFRI has initiated the telecom training program for given a platform and direction to the youngsters. In the SFRI Telecom training program from the initiation to the date, the organization has covered more than 200 beneficiaries in just only less than a year. The ratios of the beneficiaries are more than seventy percent of the women's. SFRI believes that if we efficiently empower women then it could help half of the population of needy people.

17. DISABILITY AWARENESS PROGRAMME

SFRI organized Disable awareness program in Barakhamba, New Delhi. There were many people with disability, who may require various aids for their daily needs. These assistive devices can also help people with mobility like walking; they can also help people hear, visibility, and speaks easily. All of which can range from a mild problem to complete immobility. Many people will have more than one disability, such as not being able to use their legs or hands. Also, Our Sabera foundation and research institute members distribute several instruments for disabled children.

18. LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME

An awareness generation program aimed at making women aware of their legal needs and rights awareness camps were organized by the society. These programs were organized for the rural women in large numbers and it was felt by the attendant that kind of programmers are very useful in the rural areas where women were aware of their legal rights at a very low cost Further they informed about various kinds of schemes formed and executed. The women particularly in the program were informed about the need for education and agreed to send their children

particularly the girl child to school it was resolved that the society will Further organize similar programmers shortly.

19. RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute started a rural development program for the betterment of community people with help of non-government/government agencies and community participation. For this purpose, Trust conducted a lot of activities like Awareness programs on various issues, Technology development, Formation of self-help groups among women. Now from the last few months, our organization is working in the same field for rural development as well as rural economic development through women empowerment. This program seeks to increase their economic self-sufficiency and social empowerment, eventually leading to their dynamic participation in trust. The Empowerment of the women in the field of Vocational training and education would solve most of their problems and give them self-sufficiency. Our organization work for sustainable Income Generation activities for BPL groups, women & other weaker sections through forming SHGS. We provide trading in a different trade, Organizational Management, accounting & Baking. We also provide information recanting good schemes & procedures. We help in opening bank accounts & operations.

LAST WORDS: Not ruling out unseen limitations, yet another year of dedicated efforts and noteworthy achievement of Sabera Foundation and Research Institute Trust has gone by. Along the path, while rendering services for the betterment of the underprivileged, the organization has received many cordial supports both institutional and individual that enhanced the organization's spirit and resources.
