Following are the main activities conducted during the year:

Mask Distribution and Sanitizer distribution Programme for Covid-19

The Covid-19 pandemic has been a difficult situation for all. The current coronavirus (covid-19) outbreak continues to spread, with growing numbers of confirmed cases in Delhi, Sabera Foundation and Research Institute decided to aware people stay home and safe work through distribution of masks, soaps, hand sanitizer amongst the resource fewer communities of Delhi and Uttar Pradesh to control the spread of Novel coronavirus. During this pandemic, the NGO provided packet meals to the daily wage workers and domestic help who have been rendered jobless in the current situation. SFRI is also carrying out awareness campaigns about the importance of maintaining social distance.

Free medicine distribution camp for Covid-19

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute Organized 2 no's of medicine distribution camp at Delhi, in July and September 2020, our society distributes medicines to needy and economically weaker people at our locality. We also run health checkup camps to help needy people in 2020-21. We distribute approximately two hundred people in the locality and our motive is to help more people in the future.

Health Awareness Programme for Covid-19

Covid-19 came into existence for the first time. Nobody knew how to take preventive measures. The death rate was high so Awareness programs were held day to day. Our volunteers went to people, increased their knowledge about this Virus. Distribution of Hand sanitizers was done, Proper hand washing techniques were taught. Social distancing and proper use of a three-layer mask to prevent the spread of the Virus were explained to Society.

Thus, the program focused on the importance of washing hands while two nurses volunteered to demonstrate how to wash one's hands properly, Secondly, they focused on the importance of social distancing. The society president distributes masks, soaps, sanitizers to the ones gathered for the day.

Atmanirbhar Bharat Awareness Programme

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute organized an Atmanirbhar Bharat Awareness for rural women, youth, and self-help groups belonging to below poverty line (BPL) families in November 2020. The main aim of this meeting was to tell the responsibilities to the members of the group and how can they become able to integrate the people of the society and we're always ready to solve the problems. The members appreciated this program very much.

Minority Awareness Programme

The organization is organized a day-long Multi Minority Awareness and Cultural Program at Budaun District of Uttar Pradesh state. 200 numbers Participants from nearby various areas of U.P have participated and exchanged and shared their culture by performing various cultural programs like a folk songs, drama, dances, etc. The organization invited Resource persons from various fields and they delivered valuable lectures and also group discussions of various youth-related issues.

Swachh Bharat Awareness Programme

The organization has organized an awareness program on Swachh Bharat at Budaun on 02/10/2020 under the Pradhan Mantri Swachh Bharat Yojana. The speakers delivered their valuable lecture about the Swachh and its effect on our life. More than 350 people have attended the program. As a part of the ‘Swachh Bharat Abhiyan’s a rally was taken out by Md Habibur Rahaman chief functionary of Sabera Foundation and Research Institute led the rally with students, teachers carried placards displaying messages to sensitize people about cleanliness. Students, as well as teachers, participated with enthusiasm in the cleanliness drive.

Book Fair Programme

The Bookfair was conducted from 20th to 22 Oct 2020 in the Budaun district of Uttar Pradesh. It’s a very motivated fair in this fair more than 10 publishers come and takes part in that fair. 1000 people come to take it as valuable fair. They enjoy every part of that fair and they learn more about books especially youth.

Environmental Awareness Programme

An environmental awareness program was organized by our Sabera Foundation and Research Institute at Badaun, U.P, and our staff members took part in the program enthusiastically. The slogan “Plant tree, save a life, helped raise awareness regarding the environment. As far as work for environmental issues is concerned, Sabera Foundation and Research Institute have been working to create a program, particularly among youth & children about various issues of environmental concern in its working areas. On this occasion, several activities also include the plantation of Aloe Vera, Amla, Neem, Turmeric, mango trees. Awareness activities are being organized among School going & non-school-going children both. On Environmental awareness, Programme was organized.

Yoga day Celebration Programme

Our society celebrates yoga day every year on the 21st of June. Yoga is a physical, mental, and spiritual practice that originated in India. Yoga provides peace to the mind, body, and soul. Yoga shivers are organized every year by our society.

Beti Bachao Beti Padoo Programme

The trend of decline in the Child Sex Ratio (CSR) defined as the number of girls per 1000 boys between 0-6 years of age, has been unabated since 1961. The decline in CSR is an indication of women's disempowerment. In order to battle this issue, our society organized an awareness program regarding Beti Bachao Beti padhao. Our society believes in women empowerment and educating women is the first step towards it. Our society carried out this awareness program for the same.

Art Cultural Activities

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute work to promote the high value of human brotherhood, peace, and harmony among people through cultural development activities. It works to create an environment of communal harmony and national integration in its working areas. In this context, several activities like the Independence Day celebration. Republic day celebration, cultural shows in the evening. Performance of folk music and dance, stage, and street plays, and SFRI annual day celebrations are being organized in the working areas. Sometimes society organizes cultural programs to promote peace messages. Society also organizes cultural events among children and adolescents to make them understand the diversity in culture in the country. We conduct awareness talks among students on the relevance and significance of different festivals of all religions. It creates a harmonious atmosphere among students as start knowing the importance and significance of the religions. Which he/she does not belong such programmed are organized on 24th August (Foundation day), 1st May, 15th August and 26th January every year, and the number of beneficiaries is 200.

Martial Art Activities

On 24th August 2020, SFRI organized a foundation day Programme in Raafiah college of Education, Badaun, UP. Trust collaboration with RCE staff and students conducted an hour of martial art activities session for students and interested children and locals in the nearby areas. The instructor teaches different moves of Karate and Kung Fu, also brief how important martial art is for self, mind, and body, healthy lifestyle through keeping oneself fit and fine physically, mentally and emotionally. The group learned to move differently to perform karate the test of time.

Disability Awareness Programme

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute have been conducting awareness and support-related activities in its working area to make differently able people more efficient and empowered. The organization organizes awareness camps for Mental Deaf, Dumb and handicapped people in Mata Sundari Road, New Delhi. Through various activities, the organization makes people aware of the government facilities and schemes for handicapped people. Sabera Foundation and Research Institute provide support to differently able people to get disability certificates, wheelchairs, limps and hearing aid number s of beneficiaries 25.

Skill Development and Vocational Awareness Programme

Sabera Foundation and Research Institute trust have always kept in mind that vocational training is the need of the hour to reduce the effects of unemployment. To achieve this goal the trust has started a vocational training center at its registered office at Raafiah College of Education, Sahswan, Distt-Budaun, Uttar Pradesh. The COVID-19 Pandemic has wreaked havoc across the world and has forced every organization to rethink its strategies for the future ahead. SFRI, adapting to the requirements of the times, has been organizing online events and conducting online workshops for quite a few months now. In the days ahead SFRI, apart from continuing with its online activities, is gearing up to launch an institute for skill development and re-skilling ranging from soft skills to music to create job opportunities, in a virus-ravaged world, for artists, artisans, and workers alike. From 2011 to date our Sabera Foundation and Research Institute every year teaches around 180 students Computer Courses, and stitching also conducts art camps, art exhibitions, workshops, seminars, and conferences among others.

Legal Awareness Programme

The majority of people of India are legal illiterate and not aware of the basic rights conferred upon them by law. The growing number of issues, problems,

unabated corruption, and indecisiveness prevailed in our society that has given rise to demand support from the people of the country. Be it the legal, poverty, literacy, health, environment, and many other issues - each cause is clamoring for public attention. Apart from that the trust also organized a program for women. The awareness program was organized concerning the legal rights of women. After the completion of the workshop, a rally was held in which women delivered awareness message for the prevention of violence against women to society.

Also, we created awareness about the legal actions which could be taken under IPC and CRPC for a copyright violation. Plagiarism is an issue that is very common and strict action could be taken against any such occurrence. There are legal provisions for punishing a person found guilty of such things. There have been incidences of social media accounts being hacked of people which must be brought to light. There are provisions of punishment for any such cyber frauds. Cyber security is a must and every person must be aware of it. Changing passwords at regular intervals could avoid any such occurrences.

Urdu Awareness Programme

SFRI has always been dedicated to the promotion of the Indian Language and to taking these languages in between common people by organizing cultural events of languages and other events in this concern. An Urdu Awareness Programme was organized in January 2021. For the promotion of the Urdu language and to introduce the literary work written in the Urdu language our organization has organized an event in the name of great Poet and thinker Ghalib to celebrate his literary work in Urdu language and to promote Urdu through Urdu Shayari and proses. Overall 200 people have participated in this event. The contemporary renowned Urdu poets were also being present on this occasion. A mushaira program was held for the embracement and endorsement of the magic of the Urdu language.

Earth Day Celebration Awareness Programme

SFRI is committed to working for environmental conservation and spreading awareness to protect our beloved planet- The earth. In order to its effort to work for environmental awareness, SFRI decided to celebrate the Earth day program by its member's contribution and community participation.

In Earth day celebration program was organized in Feb 2021, a day-long program has organized in which students, environment activists, local administration, Academicians and other local people had invited. The program has included the Drawing and painting competition for kids on the theme of our planet Earth. The prizes were distributed to the winning kids and a certificate had provided to every participant. The Honorable resource person delivered their valuable speech to all present participants. Overall 180 people get benefitted and were acknowledged by the discourse and symposium on environmental concern by the resource person.

On this occasion, a record number of 500 plants got planted by the participants and our guests. An Oath has taken by all the participants for conservation of our beloved planet and to plant trees around.

Rural Development Awareness Programme

SFRI started a rural development program for the betterment of community people with help of non-government/government agencies and community participation. For this purpose, Trust conducted a lot of activities like Awareness programs on various issues, Technology development, Formation of self-help groups among women. Now from the last few years, our organization is working on the same field for rural development as well as rural economic development through women empowerment. This program seeks to increase their economic self-sufficiency and social empowerment, eventually leading to their dynamic participation in society. The Empowerment of the women in the field of Vocational training and education would solve most of their problems and give them self-sufficiency. Sabera Foundation and Research Institute” work for sustainable Income Generation activates for BPL groups, women & other weaker sections through forming SHGS. We provide training in a different trade, Organizational Management, accounting & Banking. We also provide information regarding good schemes & procedures. We also help in opening bank accounts & operations.

Consumer Awareness Programme

As a part of consumer welfare programmed the organization has organized two day’s workshop & awareness camp at Delhi. Large numbers of people including youth & girls, school students have attended the camp; our resource persons have delivered lecture on consumer laws, trademark. FPO mark, ISI marks, etc. numbers of beneficiaries 350.

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
